MEDIA RELEASE 3 May 2024 THE MOST EXCEPTIONAL HOMES IN THE COUNTRY REVEALED The 2024 Houses Awards shortlist represents the pinnacle of residential design and offers compelling inspiration for all Australians

Australia's most inventive homes have been unveiled in the 2024 <u>Houses Awards shortlist</u> – the finalists in the country's premier residential design award program. The Houses Awards shed light on the latest innovations in Australian residential design. Additionally, the Awards demonstrate how the country's best architects and designers are meeting the social, environmental and economic challenges shaping Australia's housing market.

The designers of the shortlisted homes in the Houses Awards are true innovators, changing perceptions of what the contemporary "Australian" home can be. Houses magazine editor and Houses Awards jury chair Alexa Kempton explained this year's homes illustrate new ideas in sustainability, protecting and adapting non-heritage homes, multigenerational living and adapting housing for an ageing population.

"Entries in the Houses Awards often demonstrate compelling solutions to the adaptation of heritage-listed dwellings. This year, the jury was excited to see many architects and designers – and their clients – recognising the enduring value of types and eras of housing that are not yet protected by heritage listings. These are smart, sensitive and, above all, sustainable solutions that seek to conserve our built history and use resources responsibly," said Kempton.

"The jury also observed new examples of sustainable homes, including a test case for net zero housing; a vacant urban plot transformed into high-performance, small-footprint residence; a 1970s apartment building resourcefully adapted to provide much-needed rental housing; and a compact new dwelling that proposes a welcome alternative for suburban housing."

"The jury saw how the pandemic and rising cost of living has shaped what homeowners want and need in their homes. Designers have created multi-use domestic spaces to better support working from home, and to accommodate children living in the family home for longer because of the decline in housing affordability. Australia's ageing population has also inspired designers to adapt housing to meet the demands of those who are downsizing and planning for ageing in place."

As chosen by a jury of industry experts, the 2024 Houses Awards shortlist is made up of the best new houses, apartments and gardens from across the country. The full list can be viewed on the <u>Houses Awards website</u> (and in the below pages of this media release).

This year's shortlisted entries were chosen by a panel of jurors who represent the best architectural and design experts in the country. Specialist advisors provided expertise in the sustainability, heritage and landscape design categories. The 2024 jury includes:

For more than a decade, The Houses Awards have championed the very best in Australian residential design and recognised excellence beyond a home's aesthetics. The Awards are concerned with the human experience of a home



as well as the impact their construction and function have on the environment and the community around them.

The eventual winners of the 2024 Houses Awards will be announced at a gala event at Metropolis in Melbourne on Friday 2 August, with projects awarded across nine categories. One home from these nine categories is awarded the premier title of Australian House of the Year. Each award category offers a \$1,000 cash prize, and the winner of the Australian House of the Year will receive a \$5,000 cash prize.
